Beliefs & Practices: give examples (at least 3) of different beliefs and practices, including festivals, worship, rituals and ways of life and explain some meanings behind them.

Symbols and Actions: Give examples (at least 3) of symbols and actions explaining how and why they express religious meaning. Notice some similarities between communities.

Sources of Wisdom: Retell and suggest meaning to some religious and moral stories. Think, talk and ask questions about some sacred writings and sources of wisdom and the traditions from which they come.

Ultimate Questions: Ask and answer a range of how and why questions about belonging, meaning and truth, expressing own ideas and opinions.

Identify & Belonging: Talk with others about how groups express who they are and how individuals belong to communities, including faith groups. Describe what a leader does and why.

Prayer, Worship & Reflection: Explore how and where worshippers connect to prayer and worship. Participate in periods of stillness and reflection.

Prayer, worship and reflection: Communicate through talk or gesture about prayer. Experience period of stillness and reflection.

Identity and Belonging: Show awareness of things and people that matter. Link this to Religious Education learning.

Ultimate Questions: Ask and answer a range of how and why questions about belonging, meaning and truth expressing own ideas and opinions.
