Understanding of the World

This week we will be focussing on modes of transport found in the air. Transport including planes, helicopters, space shuttles and hot air balloons. We will name parts of a plane including flight deck, wing, nose and tail. We will begin naming the 7 continents.

Maths

The children will focus this week on the stable order principle - rehearsing the order of the first 5 numbers and understanding that the position each number holds in our number sequence does not change.

They will continue to work with numbers to 5, the children will develop their understanding of the ordinal aspect by investigating the difference in value of consecutive whole numbers. They will spend time discovering that each number has a value of 1 more than the previous number.

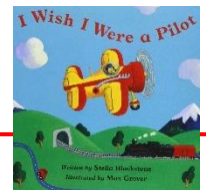
