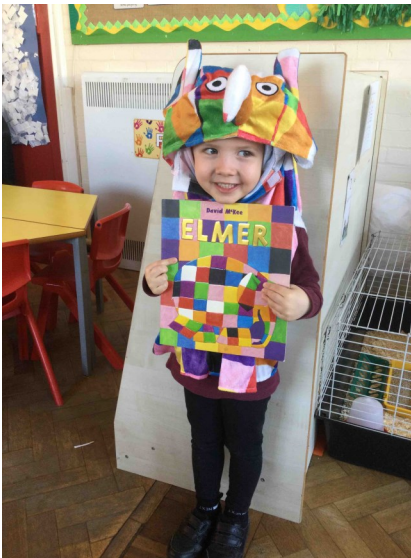

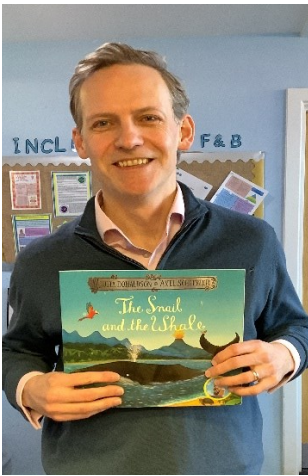
Then it was time to head to gymnastics where Dexter enjoyed spectating. On the way home, we called in at the park and had fun in the sun.

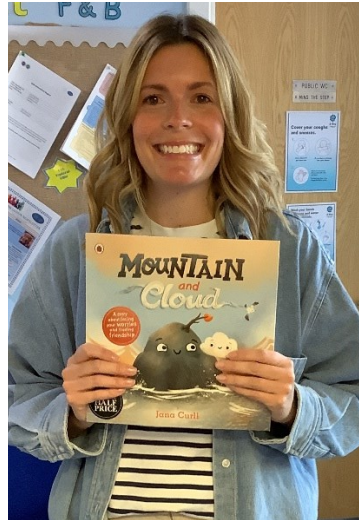
"Thank you so much for letting me read to Snowdrop class. Ivy was very surprised when she saw me as secret reader. I hope the children enjoyed listening to the story."

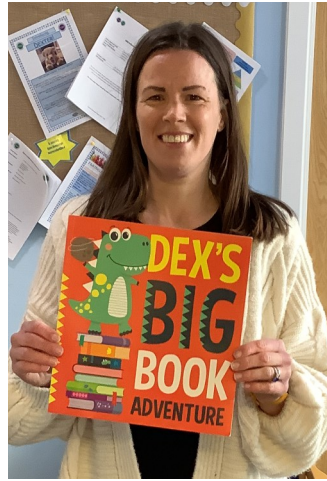
