School reopens on Tuesday 22nd April.






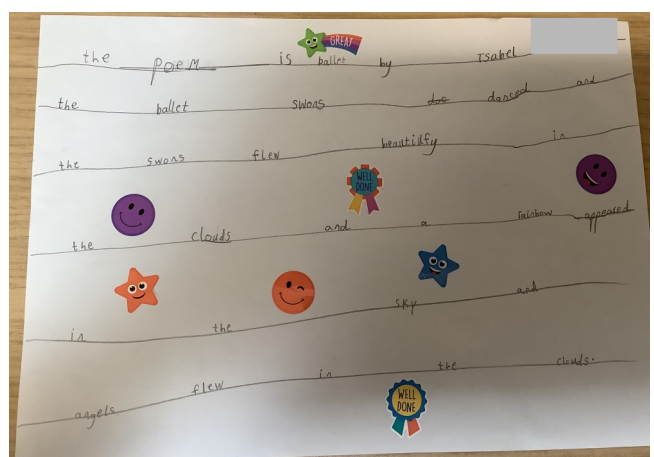
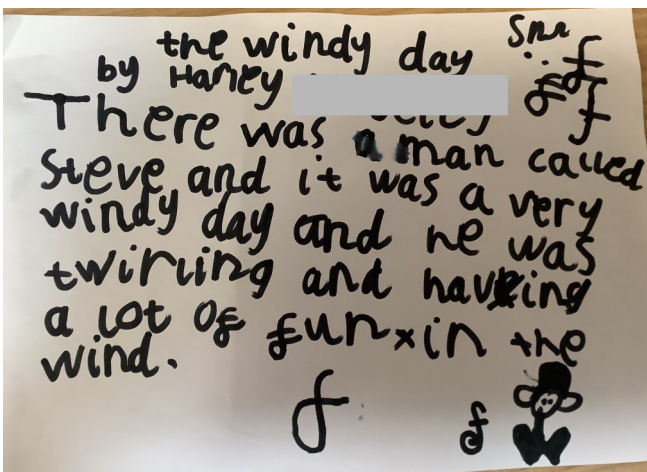
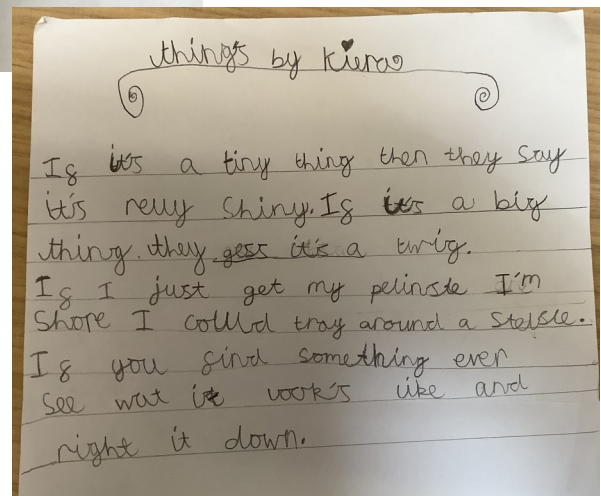
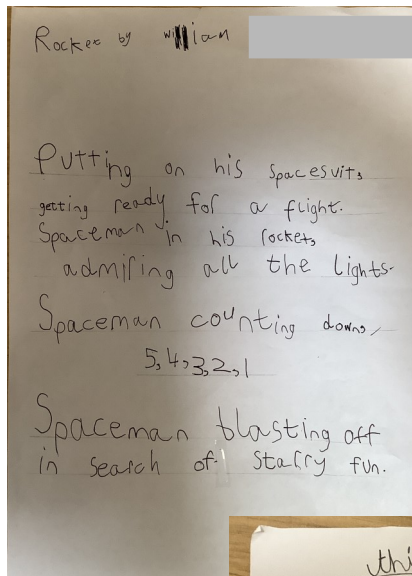
Mrs Brooker's Poetry Challenge
