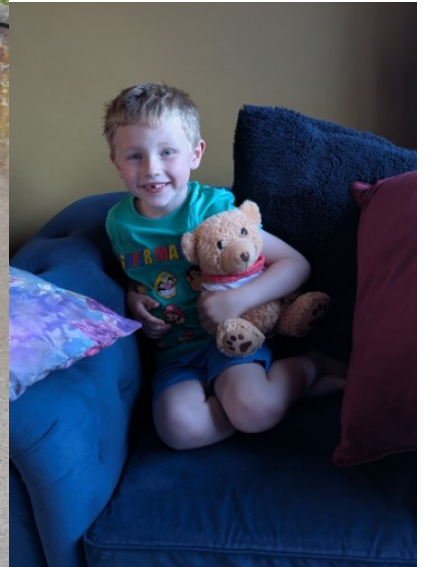
We are on Week 1 of the lunch menu

As we grow and learn throughout the year.*

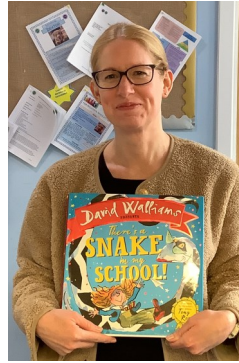

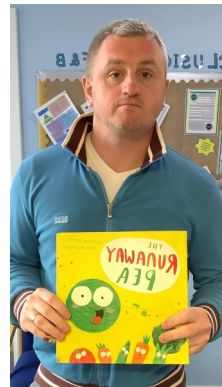
