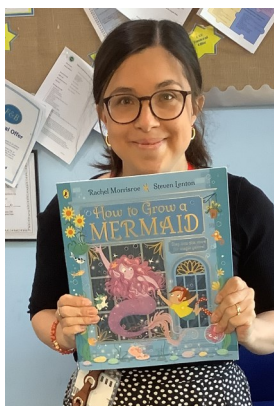

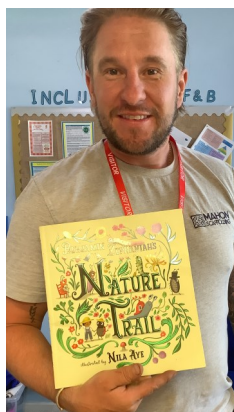


Secret Reader
