On Saturday, we took Dexter to Betsy's birthday party. He had loads of fun bouncing on the bouncy castle with the children – he was brilliant company!

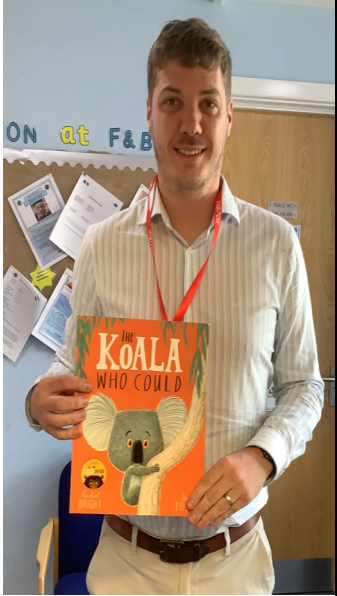
Sunday was extra special. Dexter had a ride in our classic car, Lincoln, which appeared in the film *Legend*. He looked very proud sitting with Helena and the family.

We've really enjoyed having him!"

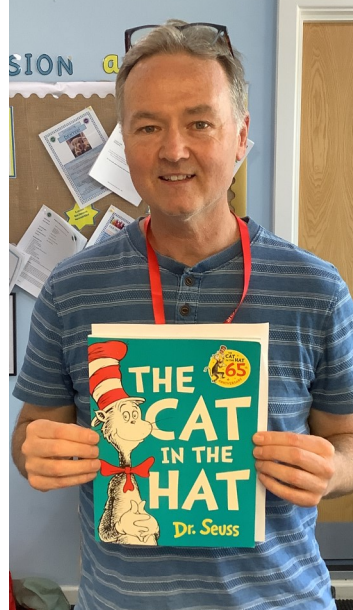

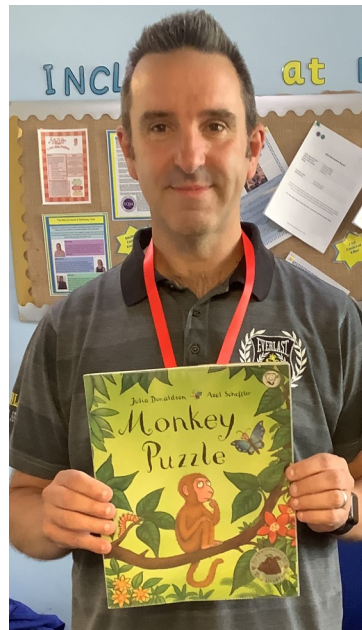
