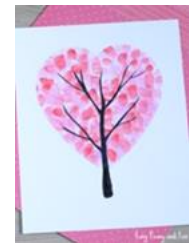
Literacy

Following on from learning about zero last week, we will be introducing the number one this week. We will be talking about what it is and how many it shows.

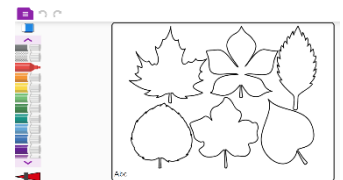


Why do you love me so much?

We will be continuing to learn how to colour in on the computers!

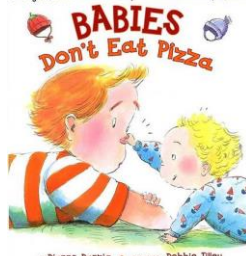


Montessori
