Understanding of the World

Next week, the children will be focussing on 'families'. They will think about who they live with at home, and make comparisons to other families. We will continue to think about how families are all special and unique, just like us as individuals!

Montessori

This week's skill is from Practical life. Sweeping helps develop a sense of order and coordination. It strengthens the finger muscles and increases concentration. It encourages independence and teaches self-care.

Maths

This week the children will explore how all sorts of things can be counted, including sounds. We will sing counting rhymes which will give them opportunities to hear, join in with and develop their knowledge of the counting sequence.

Literacy

We will begin to use the magnetic boards to build and read CVC words. We use the strategy 'Fred Talk, Read the word' to help us read. You say the sounds and then say the whole word.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be thinking about how we feel at different points of the day and how our emotions change. We will use the book 'The Colour Monster' to help us understand our feelings more.



Communication and Language

The children will continue building relationships by talking to their peers. We use 'Turn to your partner' a lot to encourage the children to talk. This week they will be talking about their home life and family members.
