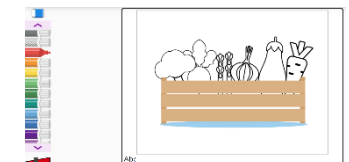


### Maths

Following on in our numbers, we will be introducing the number two this week. We will be talking about what it is and how many it shows.

### Computing

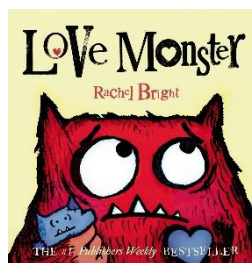
We will be continuing to learn how to colour in on the computers!



### Montessori

In this section, we will be sharing a new skill from Montessori each week.

The children will be looking at sand paper numbers. These introduce the children to the names and shapes of the symbols that represent quantities. The feel of the sandpaper against the smooth board helps guide the child's fingertip whilst they trace the symbol. The child will use their finger to trace the number, whilst saying its name. This helps physically connect the numeral to the word used. The multisensory physical engagement helps build strong memories of the symbols that will come in handy when learning to write them on paper!



### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This week we will be reading 'Love Monster' by Rachel Bright. Following this, we will be exploring the themes of the book such as what the Love Monster was looking for, and Why he though no one would love him. We will discuss how the book makes us feel, and what we can take away from it.
