Maths

In Maths next week we will be looking at estimating and ordering. They will have the opportunity to represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least.


English/Topic

The children will continue with their RWI sessions. In topic the children will be labelling the parts of flowering plants and identifying common flowers. Children will have the opportunity to look at domestic and wild animals and compare their habitats.

Home Learning

Talk Task: Please can you talk to your child about a chosen domestic/ wild animal. Can they think about any of the similarities and differences? Where might they find these animals?

Maths Task: Looking at these part whole models how many different ways can the children find to complete them? E.g $5 + 2 = 7$, $4 + 2 + 1 = 7$
