## Maths

They will also be writing about what they saw and how it made them feel.

## Home Learning

**Talk Task:** Please can you help your child to come up with the first 2 sentences of their recount after they have seen the crash Monday. (E.g. Today I saw ... It made me feel ...).

### Maths Task:

Please can you help your child understand simple addition and subtraction questions linking to more and less using different objects and act it out? For example: there are 3 toy cars in a group. 2 **more** toy cars drive up to the group. How many toys cars are there now? Can your child say this as sentence? E.g. 3 cars and 2 more cars is 5 cars.
