Understanding of the World

We will introduce the children to our new topic. We will begin by looking at signs of Autumn. The children will take a trip to the Conservation Area to collect Autumnal objects.



Expressive Arts and Design

The children will have the opportunity to access bonfire night activities on the craft shelf.



Maths

The children continue to look at how to find out 'how many' objects there are altogether.

They will continue to deepen their understanding of 5 as a quantity by linking the number itself to the 5 fingers on one hand. The children will also begin to explore ways to represent numbers to 5 using both their fingers and the Hungarian number pattern. These key representations will help to underline the 'fiveness' of 5.

Literacy

Montessori Skill

This week's skill is from Maths.

The spindles teach children to associate loose quantities with fixed symbols. This activity reinforces the concept of zero and introduces them to the symbol for zero.
