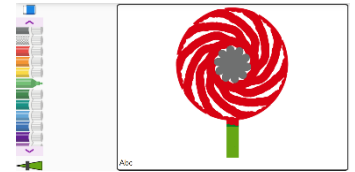


Why do leaves turn crispy?



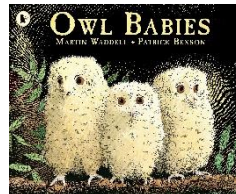
Computing
