Maths

In Maths the children will continue looking at 10 and some more. They will use the tens frames to make number beyond ten and use their knowledge of stem sentences to explain what they notice and what they can see.

English/Topic

The children will continue with English next week. They will read the story of Beegu and learn the simple rule for plurals s/es.

In topic the children will be looking at Earth's geological features such as sea, forests, lakes etc and plan their own planet. They will use Quiver in computing to bring their planet to life in 3D.
