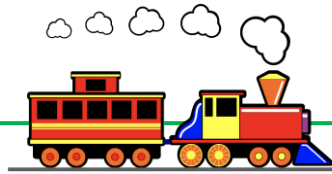

The children will have the opportunity to access topic related activities on the craft shelf.



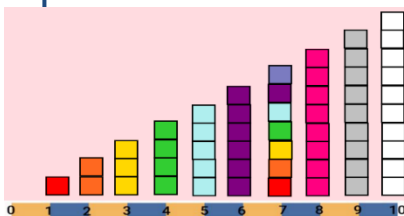
Are we there yet?



Maths

We will be focusing on keyboard skills. We will be finding the letters on the keyboard to label our pictures with our name.

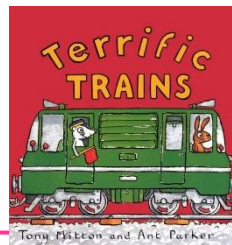
