### Expressive Arts and Design

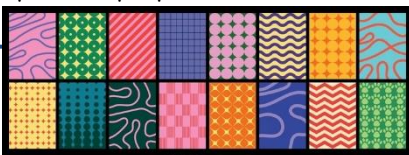
The children will have the opportunity to access topic related activities on the craft shelves.

The children will be trying hard to spot a simple pattern and continue

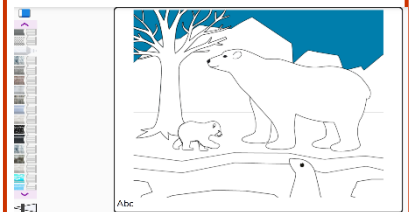


## Where does Snow go?
