We will be talking about the life cycle of a frog. We will look at each stage, and how the frog changes from frogspawn to adult frog. We will think about where frogs live and why.



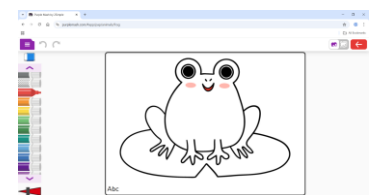
Expressive Arts and Design

The children will have the opportunity to access topic related activities on the easel.

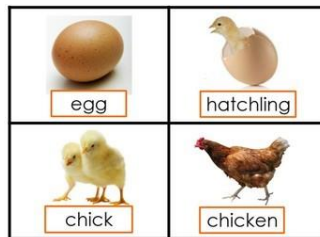


Computing

Maths

We will be looking at positional language. Whilst playing with the farm small world, we will be focussing on describing different positions. For example- The horse is next to the fence. The roof is on top of the barn.



Montessori

This week's skill is from Sensorial. The Knobless Cylinders refine a child's visual discrimination, specifically that of diameter and height. It will also develop a child's fine motor movements and hand-eye coordination.
