English/Topic

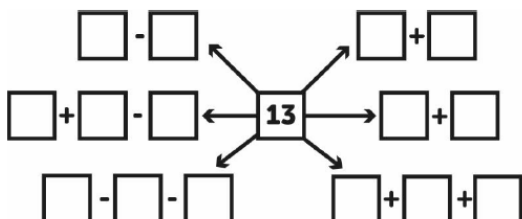
