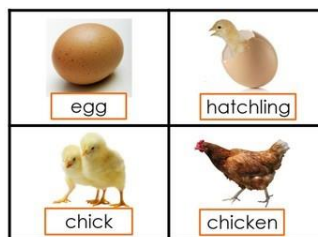


Expressive Arts and Design

Maths

Montessori
