The children will have the opportunity to access topic related activities on the craft shelf.

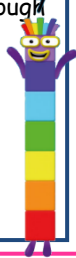


Will you read me a story?



Maths

Literacy

Next week will be focussing on the story of 'Little Red Riding Hood'. The children will be describing the Big Bad Wolf.



Montessori



This week's skill is from Maths. The 'Short Bead Stair' helps the child understand the concept of quantity in a very 'concrete' way, as they can feel it, count it, and organise it. Using two short bead stairs the children can combine the beads to add small amounts up to 20 together. This exercise shows the child a concrete way of doing addition using the tactile sense.

Communication and Language

The children will be exploring the language of capacity. They will experiment, describing how full containers are using the language full, half full, empty.
