Understanding the world

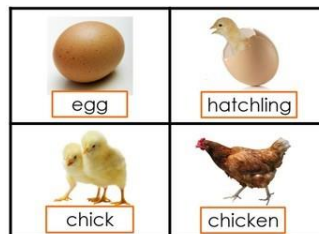
Next week we will be learning about the life cycle of a butterfly.

The children will have the opportunity to access topic related activities in the craft trays this week.

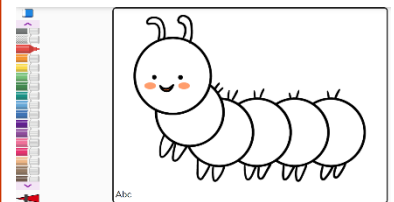


Are eggs alive?



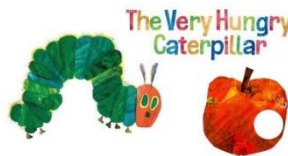
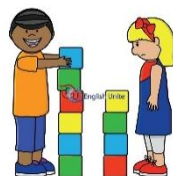
Computing
