We will be reviewing some of the sounds we have previously learnt but need a bit more practice with.

Here are some blending games you could play at home to support your child's oral blending. Focus on simple CVC words.

I-spy sound talk- Play I-spy but instead of using the first letter, say the sounds of the object. E.g. "I spy a b-a-g." "I spy a t-a-p."

Simon says- Give instructions in segmented sounds, such as "Simon says touch your kn-ee." Simon says "h-o-p".
