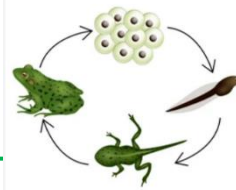

Expressive Arts and Design

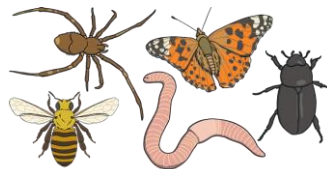
The children will have the opportunity to access topic related activities on the craft shelf.
