After a very close vote: Mrs Brennan our Mathematics lead won! The school will be voting on which Mathematical games will be purchased from her winning bid this half term.



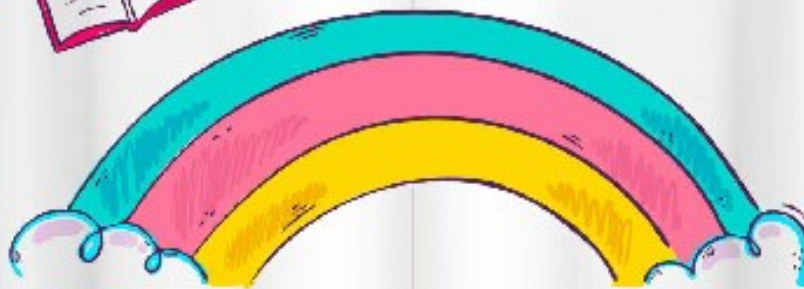

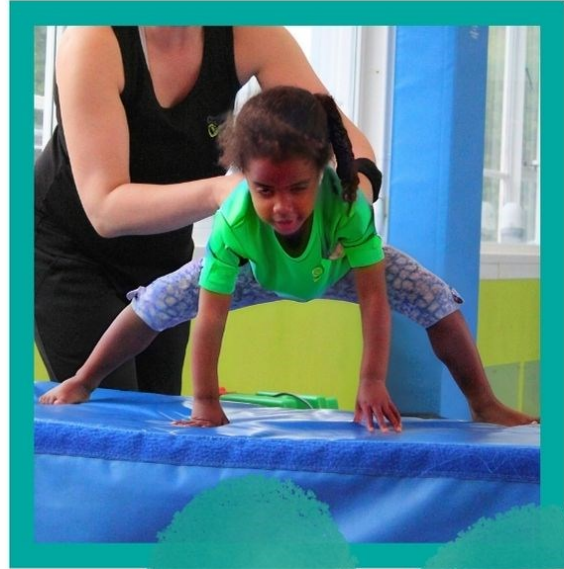

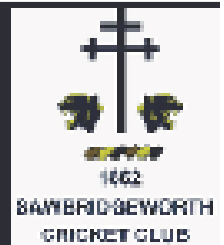
