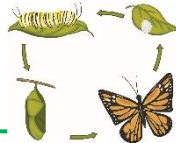

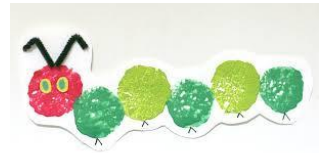
### Understanding of the World

The children will have the opportunity to access topic related activities on the craft shelf.

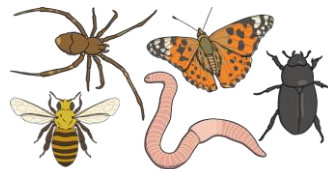


### Maths

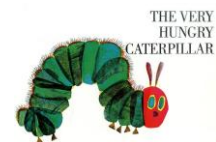
