We will be reviewing some of the sounds we have previously learnt but need a bit more practice with.

Here are some blending games you could play at home to support your child's oral blending. Focus on simple CVC words.

Sound treasure hunt- Hide objects and ask your child to find them. E.g. Find the 'm-a-p' Find the 'p-e-n'

What's missing?- Place 3-4 items on a tray, say them in Fred Talk. E.g. c-u-p, t-i-n, h-a-t. Have the child close their eyes, remove one, and ask which one is missing.

Next week we will be learning about flowers. We will learn about the basic parts of a flower, including stem, leaves and petals. We will explore what flowers need to stay alive.



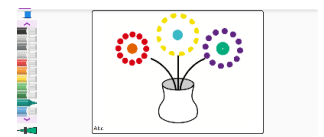
Expressive Arts and Design
