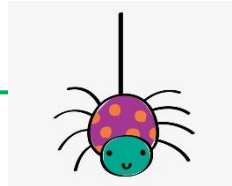

The children will have the opportunity to access topic related activities on the craft shelf.

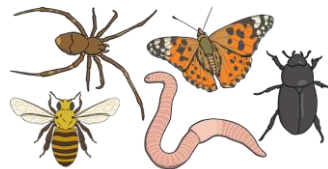


Maths

Why do ladybirds have spots?

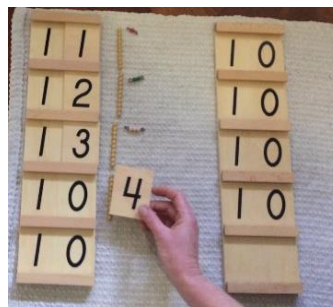
