RWI

We will be reviewing some of the sounds we have previously learnt but need a bit more practice with.

We will continue practising blending sounds into words using 'Fred Talk'.

Once the children have mastered 1) recognising all the individual sounds and 2) orally blending sounds into words, they will be ready to begin reading simple CVC words.

Maths

Montessori

When using the cards and counters, the child orders the numbers 1-10 and matches the correct number of counters to each numeral in pairs underneath. The paired pattern in which the counters are laid out introduces the concept of odd and even and gives a visual memory image.
