There are different levels: up to 10, up to 20 and more. We did up to 100 and they did so well. If you have some time do it with your child and ask them: how do you know 35 is more than 23? Give me a number that is greater than 64. Give me a number that is in between 45 and 61.

Topic: Research some famous towers. Look at pictures of the towers, describe them and find out why they were built and what they were/are used for.
