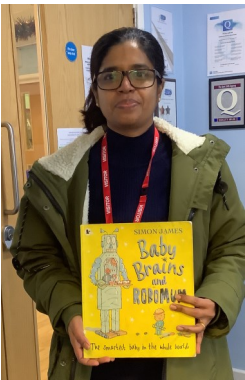
## Thank you Mr Pipe!

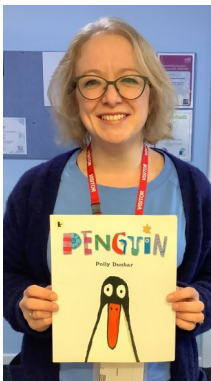
