All pupils can interact with the activities, sorting tasks, and key vocabulary that they would have seen in class or the words may be exposing them to new language.

Montessori: This week's skill is from Sensorial. The sound cylinders contain different materials that make different sounds, varying from soft to loud. Each box contains six cylinders, with a matching pair in each box. The child learns to match each cylinder to its corresponding sound partner by only using the auditory sense.

Staff book recommendations



Learning Beyond the Classroom
