Last week's staff training session was provided by Sarah Evans, our Chair of Governors, and a trained Menopause Champion and owner of Fuerte Consulting. Sarah has previously worked with staff to devise a workplace Menopause Policy and came in to talk further about what the menopause is and the symptoms and how to manage them. Additionally, she outlined that it is important that everyone knows about menopause so that support can be offered to colleagues, friends and loved ones who may be struggling with symptoms.





This coming week each class will have a parent read a story either from another country or read a story in a different language.


This is an opportunity to celebrate the world we live in and the rich languages and cultures within our school.


