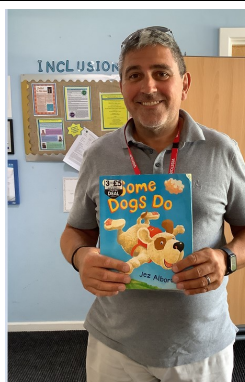


## Secret Reader
