

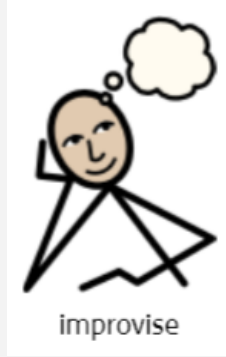

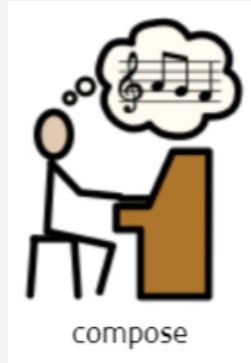
To make up a tune and play it on the spot. There is an assumption that it can never be recreated

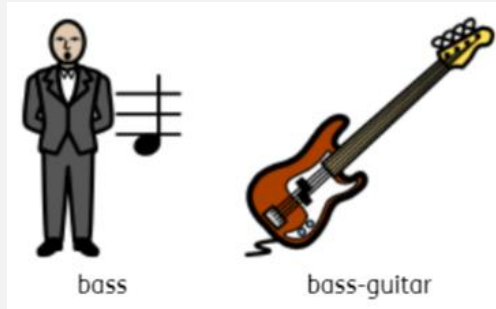

<b>guitar</b>	 <p>guitar</p>	a stringed instrument with a flat body, a long neck with frets, and usually six strings that are played with the fingers or with a pick

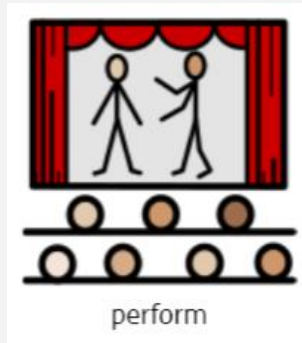
