






Blues	 <p>blues</p>	<p>A style of music characterised by its harmonic structure and the notes used to create the melodies.</p>

Baroque	 <p>Baroque</p>	<p>1600 to about 1750. It's known for its grand, dramatic, and energetic spirit</p>

<h1>Latin</h1>	 <p>latin</p>	<p>complex rhythms and beats, mesmerizing and colourful instruments.</p>

<h1>Irish</h1>	 <p>ireland</p>	<p>a diverse genre of folk music. Using an instruments such as a fiddle, flute, tin whistle</p>

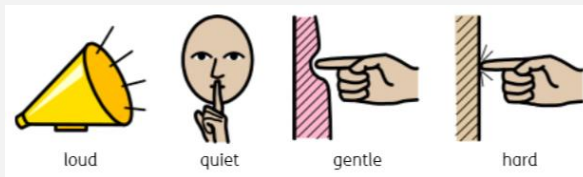

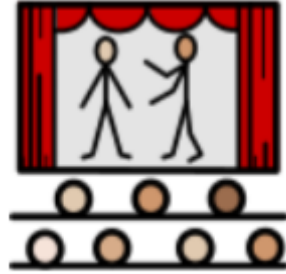
To make up a tune and play it on the spot. There is an assumption that it can never be recreated.
