


a wind instrument consisting of a conical metal tube, a cup-shaped mouthpiece, and a flared bell







**long and short sounds or patterns that happen over the pulse**




To make up a tune and play it on the spot. There is an assumption that it can never be recreated.


Creating and developing musical ideas and 'fixing' them.
