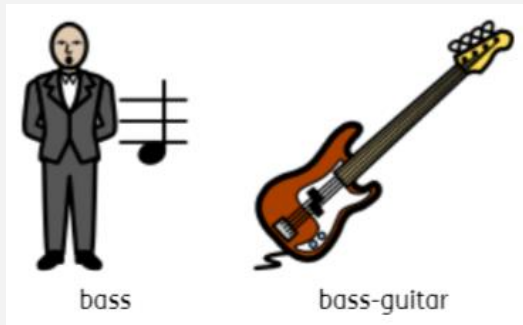

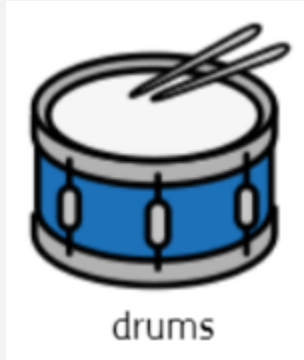
Instrument with strings: low and deep sound : the lowest range of sounds used in music.

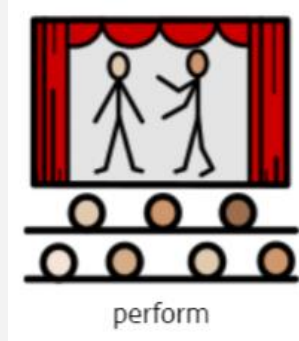
the sound of which is produced by the vibration of a stretched surface (membrane)

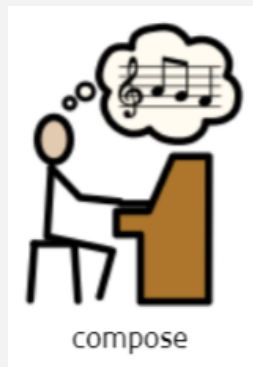
To make up a tune and play it on the spot. There is an assumption that it can never be recreated.
