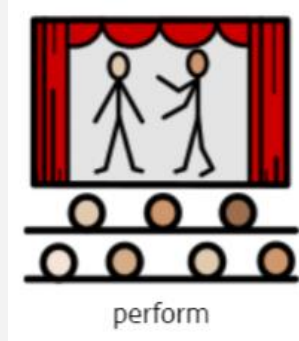

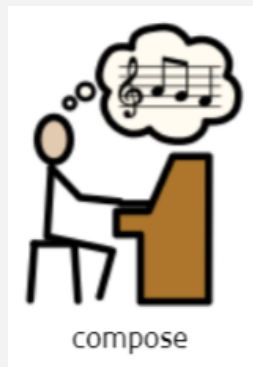
To make up a tune and play it on the spot. There is an assumption that it can never be recreated.



<b>saxophone</b>	 <p>saxophone</p>	one of a group of single-reed woodwind instruments

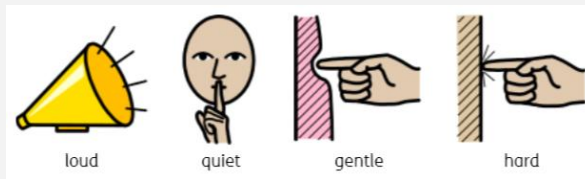

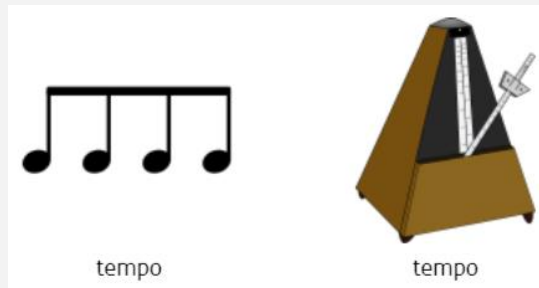

<h1>Reggae</h1>		<p>Developed in the 1970s and originated from Jamaica, Reggae defined by Bob Marley. It has a prominent bass beat and a strong off-beat usually played on the guitar.</p>
