<b>Electric Guitar</b>	 <p>electric guitar</p>	An electric guitar is structured from a wooden body with parts such strung with steel strings.

<b>saxophone</b>	 <p>saxophone</p>	one of a group of single-reed woodwind instruments

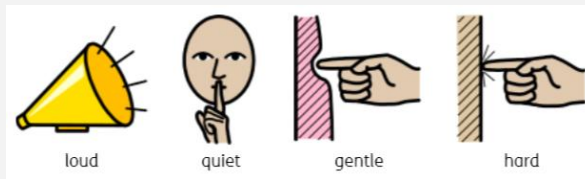

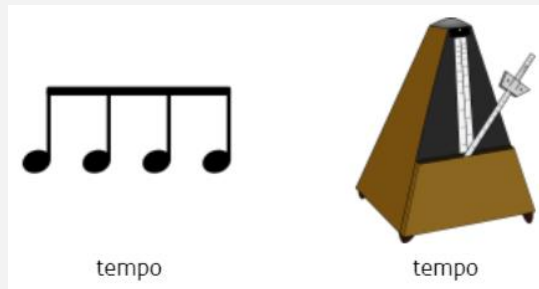
