What we will be doing next week...

Literacy: Next week we will be singing 'a is for apple' to develop the children's early phonics.

Maths: Next week we will be going on a number hunt around the classroom to demonstrate that numbers can be found everywhere!

Communication and Language: We will be talking about how some families have pets and how these are important to these families. We will read 'Rita's Rabbit' and talk about our dream pets if we could have any animal in the world.

Understanding of the World: On Monday, the children will be having their memorable experience for this topic. Elijah's mum is going to be bringing his baby sister in to show the class and talk about some of the things she uses to care for her. We will ask her lots of questions as well.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

We will be talking about how everyone is special and what makes us special with Harold the giraffe this week.

Expressive Arts and Design: The children will be making heart snails and paper plate babies this week.

Choose a Challenge:

These activities are only suggestions, feel free to do as many or as few as you like (there is no obligation to do any).

Maths: When out and about, point out numbers to your child and ask them/say what number it is, for example, house numbers on doors/bins.



Literacy: play sound 'I spy' with your child to get them familiar with listening to initial sounds in words such as "I spy with my little eye something beginning with mmm".



Understanding of the World: Talk to your child about the differences between them now and when they were babies. What questions could they ask on Monday?
