Maths

In Maths next week, the children will be looking at regrouping an amount and using a part-whole representation to record this regrouping. They will develop the vocabulary such as part number and whole number as well as familiar vocabulary such as addition and equals.

English/Topic

In Topic next week, the children will continue learning about the changing leaves and which ones are evergreen and deciduous.

They will also be creating their own woodland maps as part of Geography.

Home Learning

Talk Task: Please can you talk to your child about the different seasons and the changes that occur as we move into Autumn. Can they spot some of the changes in the local environment and use some describing words to describe them e.g the leaves are dry and crispy.

English Word: Character

Topic: Deciduous



Maths Task:

Can you ask your child what they can see? What do they notice? Can they spot a pattern or a calculation e.g $3 + 1 + 3 = 7$. Or $7 = 3 + 1 + 3$
