Next week we will be thinking about habitats within a woodland environment. We will begin thinking about where different woodland animals live, e.g. nests, burrows, dens, etc.



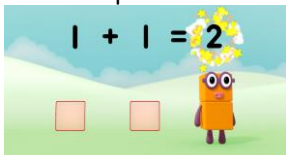
Expressive Arts and Design
