What we have been up to this week...

This week was geography week and the children learned all about Norway! They also made hedgehog land art in the conservation area.

















What we will be doing next week...

Literacy: We will continue to focus on retelling favourite stories and rhyming this week.

Maths: The children will be introduced to basic 2D shapes: circle, squire, triangle and rectangle.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

We will be discussing how to solve small problems and conflicts independently.

Understanding of the World: We will be talking about the next season being winter and how the weather gets even colder. We will have a matching activity where the children can compare things they do and need in summer vs winter!

Expressive arts and design: We will continue to learn the songs for the Christmas play.

Communication and Language: We will continue to reinforce the vocabulary we have learned this term, including 'woodland', 'hibernation' and 'nocturnal'
