












What we will be doing next week...

Literacy: We will continue to learn about rhyming as the children help the elves to pack the right presents in the rhyming colour wrapping paper (such as blue – shoes).

Maths: We will continue to learn about 2D shapes and will help Santa to deliver the correct present to the correct house!

Expressive Arts and Design: The children will be doing their big performances of the Christmas play next week (they already did amazingly in their dress rehearsal)!

Understanding of the World: The children will be learning about the Christian story of the Nativity in their RE session. They will then be able to retell this using small world figures.
