<u>Maths</u>

The children will be developing their subitising skills.

A key focus will be on developing skills of visualising; the children will be encouraged to look carefully at arrangements of dots and then to close their eyes and explain what they saw. Using spatial language to describe subgroups within these arrangements will allow them to further consider composition (the numbers within numbers eg two on the top two on the bottom).

Personal, Social and Emotional <u>Development</u>

In SCARF, we will begin to name things that keep our bodies safe. We will also name things that keep our bodies clean and protected.

Understanding of the World

In the first week back we will begin our new topic, focussing around transport and vehicles. We will have our memorable experience, where we'll go on a traffic spot, to see what modes of transport we can see/hear. We will begin to name different modes of transport and compare them.
