## MATHS

The children will use their 'think 10' strategy when subtracting a single digit number from a teen number.

## English/Topic

The children will continue with their RWI sessions.

## Home Learning

### Talk Task:

This week please can you help your child think about the four countries of the United Kingdom. Can they tell you one thing about each? It could be the colour of the flag, the capital city or a landmark they can remember.

**Topic Word:** tourist

### Maths Task:

Pick two one digit numbers from 4-9. Ask your child to 'think 10' when adding them together. For example, if they picked 4 and 8. They may say "I can regroup 4 into 2 and 2. I will add 2 to 8 to make 10 and then add 2 more which will make 12." At school we used ten frames to help us. You could draw this at home together.

**Reading Task:** Please ensure you read with your child every night and record this in their reading record.
