## **English**

In English next week we will be reading 'Through My Window' by Tony Bradman and Eileen Browne. We will use this as inspiration to write our own stories. We will learn about the features of narrative writing and focus on using our senses to describe characters and settings.

## **Maths**

In Maths we will be learning to double and half two digit numbers which end in 0 e.g. 30 and even numbers e.g. 26. We will explore this using dinennes and bar models. We will also be doing this with amounts of money when problem sovling.

## Topic

In topic we will learn about the countries that make up the UK as part of Geography and we will rehearse a piece of music to play for the music governor who is coming in to school.

#### **Home Learning Tasks**

**Spellings:** We are focusing on words that have 'a' after 'w' and 'qu' such as 'want' 'watch' 'wander' and 'squash'.

Have a go at whizzing up your own made-up words like: 'drizzbabbling' instead of just drizzling. Enjoy!
