We will be painting our own funky t-shirts on Purple Mash, thinking about patterns such as stripy and spotty.

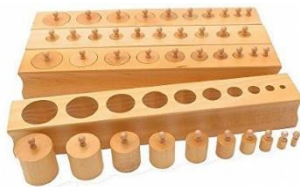


### Literacy
