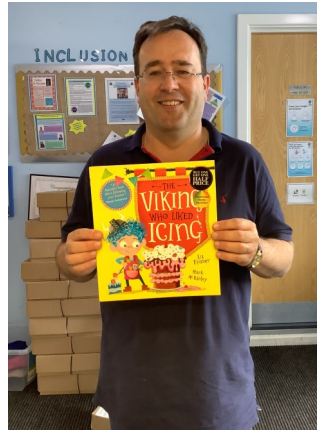


Secret Reader / Poetry

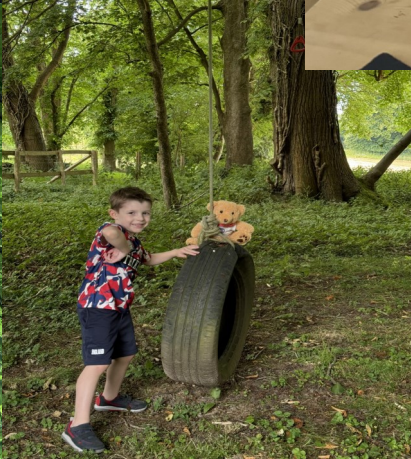
- 50 X LONG LIFE FRUIT JUICE (1 LITRE)



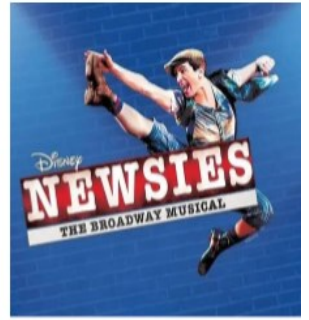
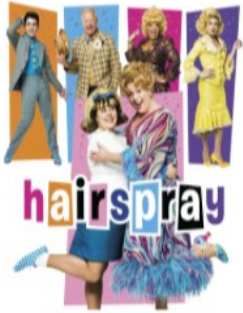
